The Alumni and Friends Association has grown more then 10,000 members in the last year, reaching more than 19,000.

Congratulations to Oklahoma and Texas, the only two states with a state alumni membership over 1,000. **Currently**


Nevada and Wyoming increased their state alumni membership fivefold. Guam and Puerto Rico each increased four-fold. Seven states tripled their state alumni membership, and 24 states doubled their alumni membership.

The top 10 alumni membership increases over last year are in Oklahoma, Texas, Michigan, Florida, Kentucky, Georgia, Missouri, Ohio, Arizona and New York.

To spark interest in joining the alumni, Nevada put an alumni table to the left of the stage during closing ceremonies. Medalists passed as they came off the stage. Maine put an alumni booth in their exhibit area. Texas Secondary used the alumni booth for alumni membership recruitment and as the delegate voting booth. Wisconsin held an alumni reception.
